“County Down” is a canny, 70-minute spoof of a low-budget soap opera-horror movie for teenagers. With digitally applied hallucinogenic visual enhancements, it revolves around the invention and distribution of a psychedelic drug — delivered and consumed in nipples baby bottles — by a teenage girl named Angel. It’s a hoot: funny and, in several meanings of the term, dreadful.
