Gibb Slife @ Fitzroy Gallery



Fitzroy Gallery inaugurates its new 195 Chrystie Street location on New York's Lower East Side with "Thick As A Brick," an exhibition of painting, sculpture, and mixed-media works by Gibb Slife that's on view through November 10. There are two-dimensional portable toilets, oil paintings of crumpled Michael Caine and Don Rickles publicity shots, and a sculpture involving a grossly oversized cigarette perched atop two dictionaries.

Fitzroy's director is Maureen Sarro, formerly of Friedrich Petzel Gallery. Their roster includes Colby Bird, Simone Forte, and Kianja Strobert (whose work is featured in the November issue of *Modern Painters*.) We're eager to see what they have planned for the coming months in this impressive new space.
